

Klang Bus Stand Traders To Move To New Premises

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 13 (Bernama) -- The 13 traders who have been operating at the Klang bus station in the city will be moving to new premises in front of the Central Market LRT station following the closure of the terminal to make way for the construction of an underground station for the MRT line.

Deputy Federal Territories and Urban Wellbeing Datuk M. Saravanan said they could operate rent-free at the new site for the first six months.

"We will hold discussions with Syarikat Prasarana Negara Berhad (Prasarana) on the next course of action for them as the MRT project is only expected to be completed in 2016," he told reporters after making a visit to the Klang bus station Wednesday.

He added that the government would ensure the welfare of the traders, who had been operating at the Klang bus station for more than 10 years, would be taken care off.
