

Utilities relocation works in Jln Damansara

KUALA LUMPUR: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) will be carrying out utilities relocation works along Jalan Damansara in front of Muzium Negara.

The water and gas pipes, and communication and electrical cables are being relocated because of the construction of the KL Sentral MRT station.

It will begin on Monday and be completed in six months.

The works will not result in the closure of lanes along Jalan Damansara.

It will be carried out during non-peak hours to minimise inconvenience to the public.

Road signs will be placed at various locations to provide warning to the public.

MRT Corp regrets any inconvenience caused during this period.

The company hopes the public understands that the works are a part of the MRT project which will bring major improvements to the city's public transport network.
