

# Redevelopment works at Klang bus stand begin

KUALA LUMPUR: Mass Rapid Transit Corp Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) has commenced redevelopment works at the Klang bus stand here.

The plan is to transform the old bus station near the Pasar Seni LRT station into a new underground Pasar Seni MRT station for the Sungai Buloh-Kajang MY Rapid Transit (MRT) line.

MRT Corp stakeholders/land director Haris Fadzillah Hassan said the top down method will be adopted in the redevelopment which is expected to be completed in six months.

"We will have a technical briefing with business owners in the area on Monday to assure them that there will be no demolition and no acquisition. And we will compensate any damage to their business," he told reporters.

The upcoming station will be a key integration point for the Pasar Seni LRT station, which is currently the busiest LRT station in terms of passenger traffic.

The bus stand is one of the three government-owned buildings in the area. The other two, the adjoining Plaza Warisan and UDA Ocean complex, will be redeveloped for the construction of the underground Pasar Seni MRT station. — *Bernama*
