

# Business as usual for BB Plaza

**PETALING JAYA:** BB Plaza will be operating as usual while Jalan Bulan 1 will be closed during the construction of BB Sentral Station.

According to a press statement yesterday, following discussions between MRT Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) and UDA Holdings Bhd (UDA), MRT Corp revised the station design that originally would have direct integration with BB Plaza.

MRT Corp is the developer of the new rail transport system that connects Sungai Buloh to Kajang, and UDA is the owner of BB Plaza.

Based on the revised design, neither the BB Plaza nor UDA office building need to be demolished to accommodate the construction of the Sentral Station.

Because of the new plans, parts of Jalan Bulan 1 (that links to Jalan Bukit Bintang) will also be temporarily

closed. The closure will take effect on Nov 30 and is expected to remain closed for four years.

Requests for kiosk operators affected by the project to defer the works until after Ramadan was turned down due to its impact on the timeline of the project.

However, following a dialogue with traders yesterday, MRT Corp agreed to allow the traders to operate until midnight July 8.
