

MRT Corp awards 4 packages worth RM767m

KUALA LUMPUR: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) yesterday awarded four work packages for the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang project with a combined value of RM767 million.

The awards were made following a sitting of the One-Stop Procurement Committee (OSTC), chaired by Second Finance Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Husni Hanadzlah in Putrajaya.

TSR Capital Bhd's wholly-owned subsidiary, TSR Bina Sdn Bhd, won the bid for two packages for the construction of carpark building, the depot and administrative building worth a combined RM329.9 million.

MRT Corp, in a statement, said OSTC awarded TSR Bina with Package MSPR1 for the construction of a multi-storey carpark building, external works and other related works at Sungai Buloh station.

The contract price is RM117.1 million. This package received bids from 17 tenderers.

TSR Bina is also the successful bidder for Package DPT2 for the construction of the Kajang Maintenance Depot, administrative building, external and associated works in a contract worth RM212.8 million.

MRT Corp said the DPT2, which is a package for Bumiputera companies, received bids from seven out of eight pre-qualified tenderers.

The OSTC also awarded Naim Engineering Sdn Bhd with Package S4 for the construction of the Section 16, Pusat Bandar Damansara and Semantan elevated stations and other related works. The contract is worth RM208.2 million.

The S4, which is an open package, received bids from 11 out of 14 pre-qualified tenderers.

Meanwhile, Package S5, which is for the construction of the Taman Bukit Ria, Taman Bukit Mewah, Leisure Mall and Plaza Phoenix elevated stations and other works, was secured by IJM Construction Sdn Bhd. The tender is valued at RM228.9 million.

IJM Construction had previously been awarded Package V5 for the construction of the viaduct guideway from the Maluri Portal to Plaza Phoenix where these four stations are located.

Package S5, which is also an open package, received bids from eight out of 14 pre-qualified tenderers.

MRT Corp said MSPR1 package is the first of nine multi-storey carpark packages to be awarded, while the remaining eight packages will be out for tender soon.

It added that package S4 and S5 are the first two of a total of eight elevated station packages to be awarded for the project.
