

MRT Corp awards 3 station packages worth RM563m

KUALA LUMPUR: Mass Rapid Transit Corp Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) has awarded three station packages to Trans Resources Corp Sdn Bhd, Ahmad Zaki Sdn Bhd and Apex Communication Sdn Bhd for the My Rapid Transit (MRT) Sungai Buloh-Kajang project, with a combined value of RM563 million.

The awards were made following a sitting of the one-stop procurement committee (OSPC) chaired by Second Finance Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Husni Hanadzlah.

MRT Corp chief executive Datuk Azhar Abdul Hamid said the MRT's OSPC has evaluated the submissions, and these awards were the best evaluated bids from the shortlisted groups.

With these contracts, he said, the MRT project moves along and three more station packages are expected to be awarded before the end of the year.

TRC Synergy Bhd's subsidiary, Trans Resources won the bid for Package S1, worth RM283.7 million, for the construction of elevated stations and other associated works at Sungai Buloh, Kampung Baru Sungai Buloh and Kota Damansara.

Ahmad Zaki, meanwhile was awarded with Package S6, valued at RM174.6 million for the construction of the Taman Suntex, Taman Cuepacs and Bandar Tun Hussein Onn elevated stations and other related works.

"The three stations will be located along the viaduct between Plaza Phoenix and Bandar Tun Hussein Onn, identified as elevated civil works package V6, which Ahmad Zaki is undertaking after being awarded with this work package, worth RM764 million earlier this year," MRT Corp said in a statement.

The OSPC has also selected Apex Communication for the RM104.7 million Package S7 for the construction of the Balakong and Taman Koperasi stations.
