

# Traffic diversions for MRT works

**PETALING JAYA:** A series of alternative routes have been identified to divert road users and avoid traffic congestion at various construction stretches within the My Rapid Transit (MRT) project.

Speaking at a media briefing yesterday, Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) strategic communications and public relations director Amir Mahmood Razak said the affected routes identified by MRT Corp and its project delivery partner MMC Gamuda KVMRT (PDP) Sdn Bhd are:

- 1) Kota Damansara - TTDI: users are advised to use the SPRINT highway as alternative;
  - 2) Jalan Duta - Jalan Tun Razak: users are advised to use Jalan Parlimen, Jalan Raja Chulan and Jalan Loke Yew; and
  - 3) Jalan Tun Razak - Jalan Cheras: users are advised to use the KL - Seremban Highway and East West Link.
