PUTRAJAYA: The Malay Chamber of Commerce Malaysia has criticised the government on the issuing of MRT tenders, saying its members were sidelined and unqualified contractors awarded jobs. “Of the (tenders for the) RM36 billion MRT project, we have got nothing. Those who have (received contracts) are outsiders,” chamber president Datuk Syed Ali Alattas told a press conference. “They have failed to deliver trains, but are given the MRT project.”
