
MMC Gamuda denies hiring thugs

KUALA LUMPUR: MMC-Gamuda KVMRT (T) Sdn Bhd, the developer of the Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) project, dismissed as baseless” claims that it had hired thugs to scare two car park operators.

In a statement to *theSun* yesterday, the company said that it had negotiated the lease from the land owners, Pavilion Entertainment Corporation, for the use of certain plots of land located at the Jalan Bukit Bintang/Jalan Pudu junction, to construct a shaft for launching the tunnel boring

machines.

It said the company had already occupied certain plots vacated by the car park operators, which were now being prepared for site establishment to commence construction works.

“MMC Gamuda KVMRT

is unaware of any other issues that affect this arrangement, other than awaiting the release of the remaining plots. Additionally, all the allegations as claimed by the car park operators are baseless,” it said.

On Monday, two car park operators claimed that thugs from the developer of the MRT was trying to scare them off from a piece of land which they rented from Pavilion Entertainment.

They had lodged several police reports on the matter.
