MRT CORP AWARDS 3 SYSTEM WORK CONTRACTS

Kuala Lumpur, 5 February 2013: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) has awarded three system work packages for the Klang Valley MRT Project Sungai Buloh-Kajang Alignment, with a total value of RM302 million.

The awards were made by the One-Stop Procurement Committee (OSPC) which was chaired by Minister of Finance II YB Dato' Seri Ahmad Husni Hanadzlah.

The OSPC awarded the contract for the engineering, procurement, construction, testing and commissioning of platform screen doors and automatic platform gates for the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang Line (Package SBK-S-04) to Singapore Technology Electronics Limited. This contract is worth RM78.1 million.

Meanwhile, the contract for the design, supply, installation, testing and commissioning of escalators and travelators system for all 24 elevated stations of the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang Line (Package ETS-E) was awarded to MS Elevator (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd. This contract is valued at RM102.7 million.

The OSPC also awarded Affiliated Computer Services Solutions France SAS the contract for the engineering, procurement, construction, testing and commissioning of the automatic fare collection system for Package SBK-S-09. This contract is worth RM120.8 million.

MRT Corp Chief Executive Officer Dato' Azhar Abdul Hamid said the award of the three system work packages were made based on the best evaluated tenders.

"This is to ensure that contractors with the necessary capabilities and experience are selected, enabling the MRT project to get the best quality at the best price," he said.

With the award of these three contracts, there are 29 work packages left to be awarded for the construction of the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang.

About the MRT Project

MRT is a new rail transport system for the Klang Valley. It is part of the Government's Greater Kuala Lumpur/Klang Valley's National Key Economic Area (NKEA), under the Economic Transformation Programme. The Sungai Buloh – Kajang Line runs for 51 kilometres, from the north-west town of Sg Buloh to the south-east city town of Kajang. Upon completion, it will comprise 31 stations, and serve 1.2 million people along the route. It will also have strategic integration with the Klang Valley's existing rail transport network, namely the LRT, Monorail and KTM Komuter, as well as intra and inter-city bus routes. The end result will be better connectivity for Kuala Lumpur and its surrounding cities, while reducing the number of cars that enter the capital.
