# PARTIAL LANE CLOSURES AT JALAN DAMANSARA, JALAN KAMUNING, JALAN CHERAS AND THE EAST-WEST LINK

**Kuala Lumpur, 29 March 2013:** Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) wishes to announce partial lane closures at two locations to facilitate works for MRT underground stations. The affected areas are as follows:

### i. Jalan Damansara near Muzium Negara

There will be a temporary lane closure involving an 80-metre stretch of the left-most lane of the Bangsar-bound side of Jalan Damansara near Muzium Negara to facilitate soil investigation works.

The closures, which are essential for the construction of the KL Sentral MRT station, will be implemented between **31 March 2013 and 12 April 2013** between 10:00pm and 5:00am. There will however not be any lane closure during the weekends.

The location of the affected stretch of road is shown in Map 1.

### ii. Jalan Kamuning

There will be a partial lane closure at Jalan Kamuning, off Jalan Imbi, between **2 April 2013 and 5 April 2013**, involving a 170-metre stretch of the road. The closure, which is for the construction of the Pasar Rakyat MRT station, will take effect between 9:00am and 7:00pm to facilitate interlocking concrete pavement works in the area.

The existing two-lane one way road will be reduced to one lane and road users are advised to be alert of the works being undertaken at the area.

The location of the affected road is shown in Map 2.



**iii. Jalan Cheras (Taman Len Sen ramp)**

There will be night partial closure of the left-most lane of the Taman Len Sen ramp for 12 nights from **1 April 2013 to 12 April 2013**. This is to facilitate tree relocation activities along the 250 meter stretch of the road.

The partial lane closure will be effective from 10:00pm to 5:00am.

**iv. East-West Link**

There will be night partial closure of the two left lanes of the Lebuhraya Hubungan Timur Barat underpass (Kajang bound) for 10 nights from **1 April 2013 to 10 April 2013**. The length of the affected stretch is 150m. The partial closure is to facilitate tree relocation activities.

The lane closure will be effective from 10:00pm – 5:00am.

Please see Map 4 for the location of the affected stretch of road.

For all the above partial lane closures, safety barriers, hoardings and traffic cones will be installed at the work site to ensure road users and pedestrians are well-informed of on-going works.

MRT Corp wishes to apologise for any temporary inconvenience caused to the public during the construction of this world-class public transport facility that will benefit Malaysians at large.

The Sungai-Buloh Kajang Line will comprise 31 stations, and serve 1.2 million people along the route. It will also have strategic integration with KL's existing rail transport network, namely the LRT, Monorail and KTM Komuter, as well as intra and inter-city bus routes. The end result will be better connectivity for KL and its surrounding cities, while reducing the number of cars that enter the capital.
