# MRT CORP AWARDS FIRE DETECTION AND PROTECTION SYSTEM CONTRACTS

**Kuala Lumpur, 27 May 2013:** Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) has awarded two work packages for fire detection and protection systems for the Klang Valley MRT Project Sungai Buloh-Kajang (SBK) Line, with a total value of RM54.25 million.

The awards were made by the One-Stop Procurement Committee (OSPC) during a meeting which was chaired by the Secretary-General of the Treasury Dato' Sri Dr Mohd Irwan Serigar Abdullah.

The OSPC awarded the contract for the supply, procurement, installation, testing and commissioning of fire detection and protection system for elevated stations in Packages V1 and V2 as well as the Sungai Buloh Depot to P.J. Indah Sdn Bhd. The contract is worth RM31.97 million.

The contract for the supply, procurement, installation, testing and commissioning of fire detection and protection system for elevated stations in Packages V7 and V8 as well as the Kajang Depot was awarded to Mecomb Malaysia Sdn Bhd. The contract is valued at RM22.28 million.

MRT Corp Chief Executive Officer Dato' Azhar Abdul Hamid says there remain 19 packages that are yet to be awarded from the 85 total packages for the project.

"In a period of 18 months, we completed awarding the main civil works, and all system works packages. Now, we are awarding the remaining work packages, with the contracts for multi-storey carparks, LED lighting, furniture, signage and escalators for underground stations remaining. With the project progress now at 14% and growing, more and more contracts will be awarded in the coming months," explained Dato' Azhar.



Last month, MRT Corp announced the project progress at 14%, and also revealed the design of the Siemens trains that will be used for the SBK Line. The train design – codenamed Guiding Light - was undertaken by BMW Group Designworks USA.

### **About the MRT Project**

*MRT is a new rail transport system for the Klang Valley. It is part of the Government's Greater Kuala Lumpur/Klang Valley's National Key Economic Area (NKEA), under the Economic Transformation Programme. The Sungai Buloh – Kajang Line runs for 51 kilometres, from the north-west town of Sg Buloh to the south-east city town of Kajang. Upon completion, it will comprise 31 stations, and serve 1.2 million people along the route. It will also have strategic integration with the Klang Valley's existing rail transport network, namely the LRT, Monorail and KTM Komuter, as well as intra and inter-city bus routes. The end result will be better connectivity for Kuala Lumpur and its surrounding cities, while reducing the number of cars that enter the capital.*

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
