BURST WATER PIPE AT PERSIARAN SURIAN

Kuala Lumpur, 15 February 2014 (4.00pm): Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) wishes to inform the media that construction work for the MRT Project had resulted in a 900mm water pipe at Persiaran Surian being damaged.

The incident occurred at about 10.15am today and caused the intersection of Persiaran Surian and Jalan PJU 7/8 near the Ikano Power Centre in Mutiara Damansara, Petaling Jaya to be flooded.

Some water had also flowed into the basement carpark of the Ikano Power Centre, reaching around 10 carpark lots in Basement P2. No other buildings in the vicinity were affected by the flooding.

Syabas was immediately notified of the incident and they have managed to close the valve for the water pipe. Water has now stopped flowing from the damaged pipe.

The MRT Project Works Package Contractor for this area Mudajaya Corporation Bhd immediately deployed its Emergency Response Team to help manage traffic in the area. As at 3pm today, flooding on the road had receded and traffic flow is back to normal at the intersection.

MRT Corp, its Project Delivery Partner MMC Gamuda KVMRT (PDP) Sdn Bhd and the work package contractor for this section Mudajaya Corporation Bhd have immediately launched an investigation to determine what had occurred. The areas affected by the water supply cut are also being established.

MRT Corp apologises for the incident and for the inconvenience caused. All efforts are being taken at this moment to ensure that the situation returns to normal as quickly as possible.

MRT Corp will be issuing a further media statement later today with further updates on the situation.
