MRT CORP: WE DID NOT ASK FOR MONORAIL SERVICE SUSPENSION

Kuala Lumpur, 2 July 2014: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) refers to a report which appeared in The Malay Mail Online which reported that MRT Corp had asked for the monorail service to be suspended between Imbi and Hang Tuah stations following the road collapse incident.

MRT Corp Director of Strategic Communications and Public Relations, Encik Amir Mahmood Razak said MRT Corp did not at any time request for the monorail service to be suspended.

"The incident which occurred at the Jalan Imbi-Jalan Pudu-Jalan Hang Tuah intersection is not connected to the MRT Project. It does not affect the MRT Project in any way whatsoever," he said.

Furthermore, Encik Amir said MRT Corp is not the operator of the KL Monorail service.

"We hope that this sufficiently clarifies the inaccuracy which has been reported," he said.

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
