

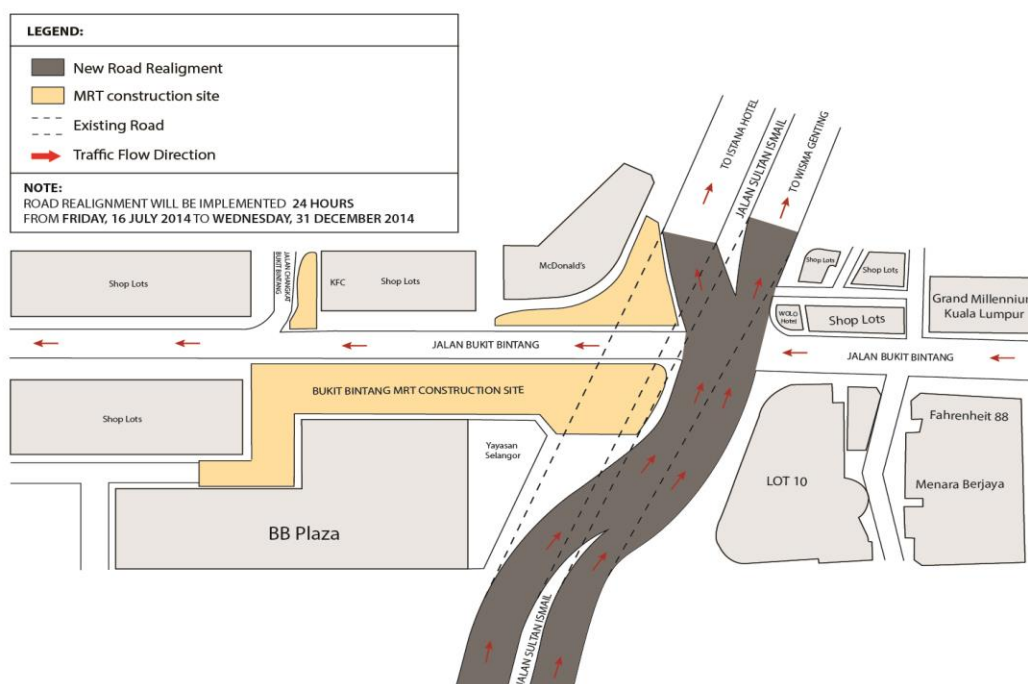
LONG-TERM TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PLAN INVOLVING ROAD REALIGNMENT IN BUKIT BINTANG

Location	Jalan Bukit Bintang and Jalan Sultan Ismail intersection
Date	16 July 2014 – 31 December 2014
Time	24 hours daily
Duration	169 days
Reason	Subway construction works

KUALA LUMPUR, 14 JULY 2014: MMC Gamuda KVMRT (T) Sdn Bhd wishes to announce the implementation of a long-term traffic management plan involving road realignment on Jalan Bukit Bintang and Jalan Sultan Ismail intersection between **16 July 2014 and 31 December 2014.**

The traffic management plan, involving the realignment of five lanes – three lanes towards Istana Hotel and two lanes towards Wisma Genting will be realigned towards the right side of the road, facing Lot 10 and several metres after Wolo Hotel. Please see the map below for the road realignment.

“The road realignment is necessary to facilitate the subway construction for the Bukit Bintang MRT station and it is part of our traffic management plan to ensure that the traffic flow along the busy Bukit Bintang area is not severely impacted by the works being carried out,” said Dr Bhavani Krishna Iyer, Head of Public Relations and Communications of MMC Gamuda KVMRT (T) Sdn Bhd.

Bhavani said during the implementation, an efficient traffic management plan will be implemented to ensure minimum inconvenience to road users and pedestrians. Motorists are reminded to drive carefully near MRT worksites and to follow directional signs.

Safety barriers, and traffic cones will be installed at the work sites to ensure road users and pedestrians are well-informed of on-going works. In addition, a 24-hour MRT Ronda will be patrolling along the route to attend to any emergencies.
