REMAINS OF VICTIMS ARRIVE IN BANGLADESH

Kuala Lumpur, 21 August 2014: The remains of the three victims of Monday's night incident at the MRT worksite near Kota Damansara have arrived in Bangladesh this morning.

The remains of Mohamad Faruk Khan, aged 38, Mohammad Alauddin Mollik, aged 34 and Mohammad Elahi Hossain, aged 27 arrived at the Shahjalal International Airport in Dhaka at 8.00am Malaysian time.

The remains were sent off from Kuala Lumpur International Airport at 3.00am on the same day. Present during the send-off was MRT Corp Acting Chief Executive Officer, En Haris Fadzilah Hassan and Director of Strategic Communications and Public Relations, En Amir Mahmood Razak.

Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) would like to thank the Bangladesh High Commission for their cooperation and assistance in arranging for the repatriation of the remains. The Commission is also in contact with the families of the victims for the following arrangements.

MRT Corp expresses its deepest condolences to the families of the victims and regrets the unfortunate incident. Investigations are underway to determine the cause of the incident. Once completed, action will be taken against the responsible party.

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
