INCIDENT AT FEDERAL HIGHWAY NOT RELATED TO THE MRT PROJECT

Kuala Lumpur, 23 November 2014: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) would like to clarify an issue that has been gaining traction on social media over the last 24 hours.

An incident had occurred at a construction site along the Federal Highway, near Subang Jaya and it has been mistakenly associated to the Sungai Buloh - Kajang (SBK) Line of the Klang Valley Mass Rapid Transit (KVMRT) project.

The SBK Line does not pass through Subang Jaya or the Federal Highway, and therefore the incident is in no way associated with the SBK Line or the KVMRT project.

While we understand the concerns of the public, we urge everyone to be responsible in spreading news without verified information.

Queries related to the incident should be directed to either the project owner or to the highway concessionaire.

We thank you for your understanding on this sensitivity and once again urge everyone to practice responsible and accountable reporting when sharing such reports among your social groups. Misleading and malicious social media updates can be very damaging to public confidence for the KVMRT project.

MRT Corp has always practiced transparency in dealing with stakeholders, always reaching out first to offer first-hand information. We fully intend to maintain this approach in keeping with our high standards of transparency, and to assure the public of the latest updates as and when they become available.
