**ADDITIONAL TWO NIGHTS ROAD CLOSURE ON JALAN DAMANSARA,
IN FRONT OF MUZIUM NEGARA
&
LONG-TERM PARTIAL ROAD CLOSURE IN JALAN CHANGKAT BUKIT BINTANG**

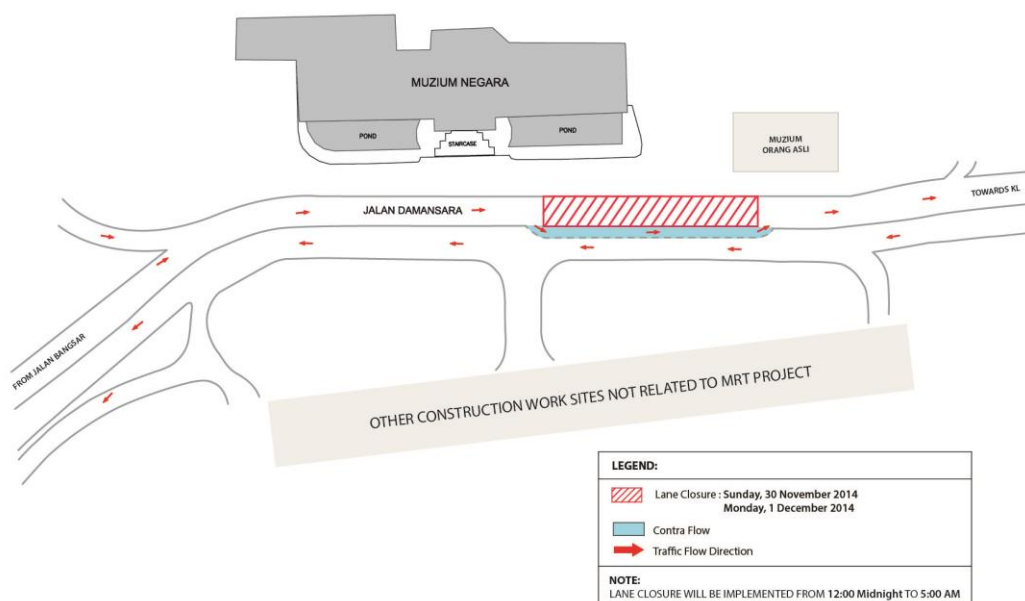
1: ADDITIONAL TWO NIGHTS ROAD CLOSURE ON JALAN DAMANSARA, IN FRONT OF MUZIUM NEGARA

Additional two nights road closures along Jalan Damansara (City-bound) in front of Muzium Negara will be implemented on **30 November 2014** and **1 December 2014** respectively, from **12 midnight till 5 am**.

The temporary night road closures, involving three lanes (City-bound) is necessary to facilitate the unloading of construction materials into the work site at the underground MRT Muzium Negara station.

A contraflow will be provided during the closure for vehicle heading towards the city centre by diverting them towards the opposite road. Please see map below on the location of the closure and contraflow.

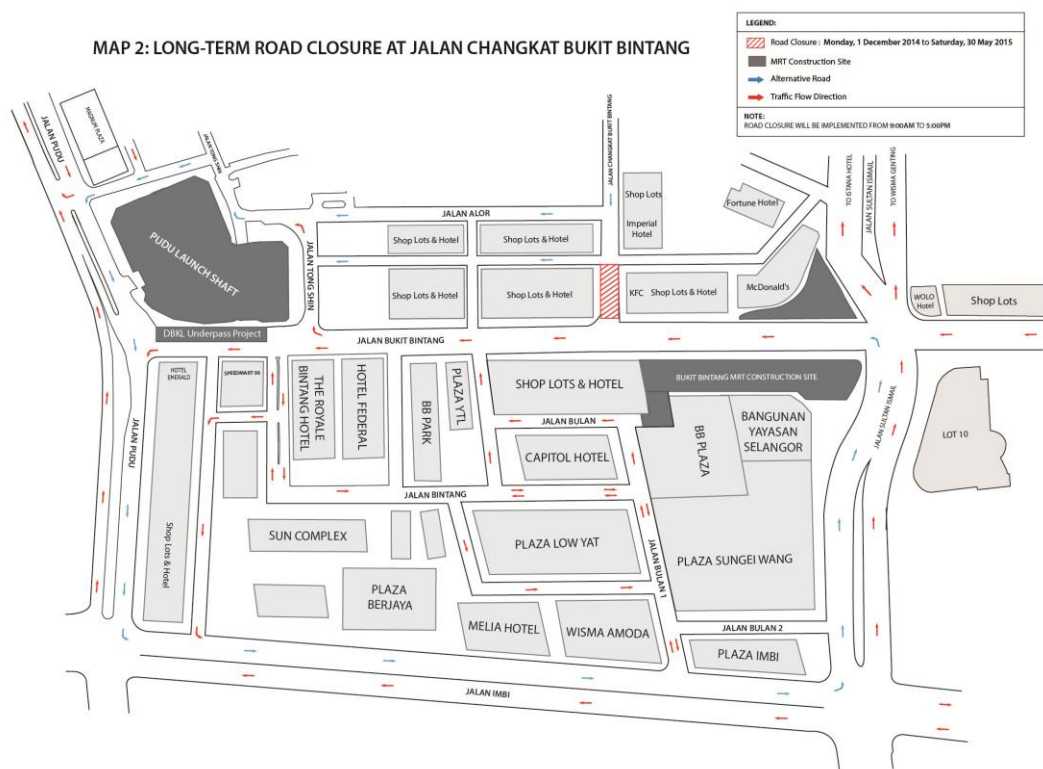
MAP 1: ADDITIONAL TWO NIGHTS ROAD CLOSURE ON JALAN DAMANSARA



2. LONG-TERM PARTIAL ROAD CLOSURE IN JALAN CHANGKAT BUKIT BINTANG

Long-term partial road closure along Jalan Changkat Bukit Bintang, next to the KFC Restaurant in Bukit Bintang will be implemented from **1 December 2014 till 30 May 2015**, to facilitate construction of entry points to the Bukit Bintang MRT station.

The closure of the 100-metre stretch will be implemented **between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm daily**. During the closure, alternative roads towards Jalan Bukit Bintang are provided via the backlane before the beginning of the closed stretch at Jalan Changkat Bukit Bintang and via Jalan Alor towards Jalan Pudu, Jalan Imbi and Jalan Sultan Ismail. Please see map below on the location of the closure and the alternative roads.



Motorists are advised to follow the directional signage and during the closure, the MRT Project Emergency Response Team will be deployed to help direct traffic. MGKT wishes to apologise for the inconvenience caused.
