

**TRAFFIC ANNOUNCEMENT UPDATES FOR MRT CONSTRUCTION WORKS
ON JALAN DAMANSARA AND JALAN SULTAN ISMAIL AND JALAN BUKIT
BINTANG INTERSECTION**

KUALA LUMPUR, 30 JANUARY 2015: MMC Gamuda KVMRT (T) Sdn Bhd (MGKT) wishes to announce short-term night lane closure on Jalan Damansara (KL bound) and long-term road realignment on Jalan Sultan Ismail and Jalan Bukit Bintang intersection. Details of the closure and realignment are as below:

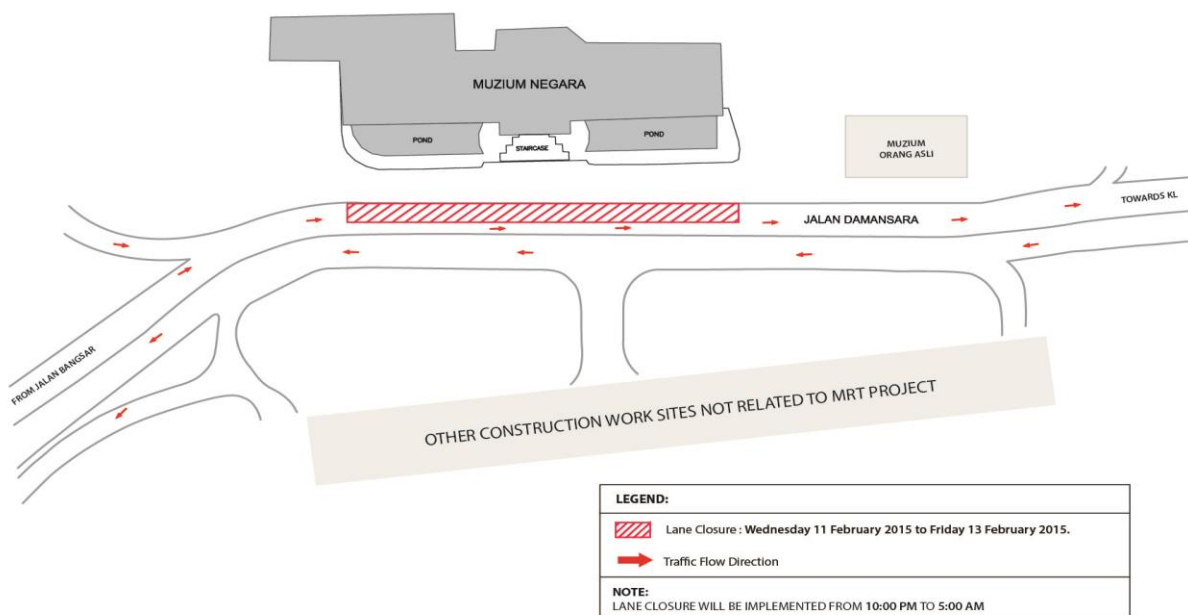
1. NIGHT LANE CLOSURE ON JALAN DAMANSARA

Location	Jalan Damansara (near Muzium Negara)
Date	11, 12 and 13 February 2015
Time	10:00 pm – 5:00 am
Duration	3 nights
Reason	Removal of construction waste and materials from the station box

The lane closure, involving a 30-metre stretch of the two left lanes (KL city bound) along Jalan Damansara near Muzium Negara will be implemented on **11, 12 and 13 February 2015**.

The closure is necessary to facilitate removal of construction waste and materials from the station box at the Muzium Negara MRT underground station site. The fast lane will remain open for traffic during the closure. Please see Map 1 below on the location of the closure.

MAP 1: NIGHT LANE CLOSURE ON JALAN DAMANSARA



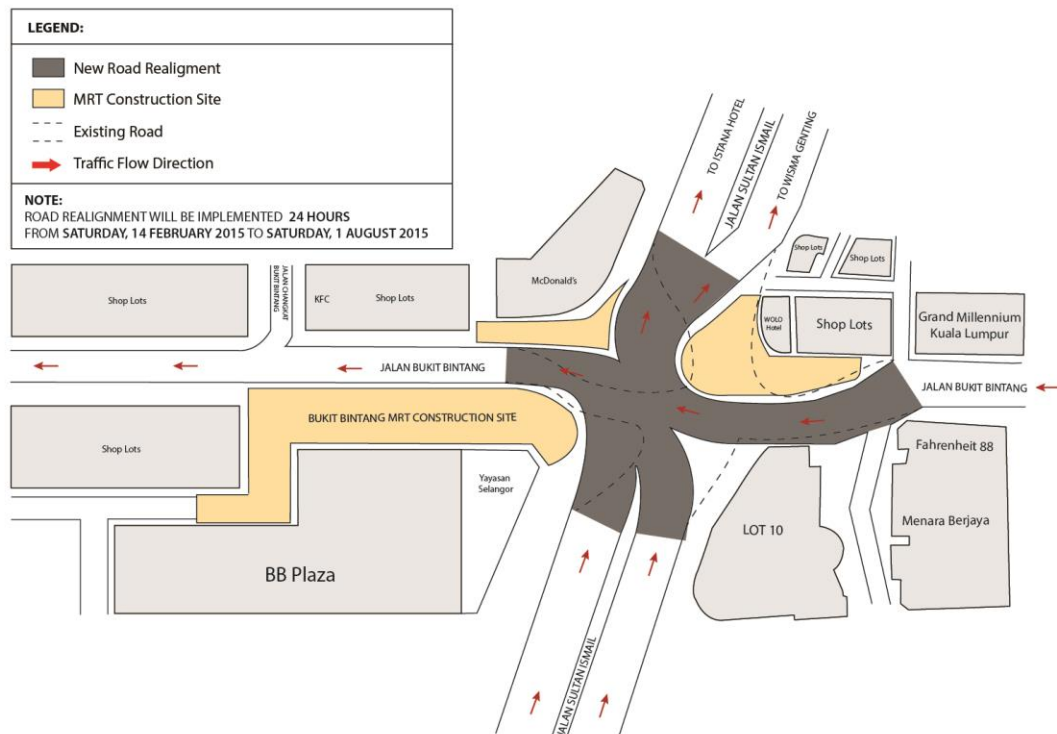
2. LONG-TERM ROAD REALIGNMENT ON JALAN SULTAN ISMAIL AND JALAN BUKIT BINTANG INTERSECTION

Location	Jalan Sultan Ismail and Jalan Bukit Bintang intersection
Date	14 February 2015 – 1 August 2015
Time	24 hours daily
Duration	169 days
Reason	Subway construction works

There will be a long-term traffic management plan involving road realignment on Jalan Sultan Ismail and Jalan Bukit Bintang intersection between **14 February 2015 and 1 August 2015**.

The traffic management plan will involve the realignment of five lanes in Jalan Sultan Ismail – three lanes towards Istana Hotel and two lanes towards Wisma Genting. The lanes will be realigned towards the left side of the road in front of McDonald's while the affected road on Jalan Sultan Ismail will also be realigned towards the left side nearer to Lot 10 entrance. “The road realignment is necessary to facilitate the subway construction for the Bukit Bintang MRT station and it is part of our traffic management plan to ensure that the traffic

flow along the busy Bukit Bintang area is not severely impacted by the works being carried out,” said Dr Bhavani Krishna Iyer, Head of Public Relations and Stakeholder Management of MMC Gamuda KVMRT (T) Sdn Bhd.

Bhavani said during the implementation, an efficient traffic management plan will be implemented to ensure minimum inconvenience to road users and pedestrians. Motorists are reminded to drive carefully near MRT worksites and to follow directional signs.

Safety barriers, and traffic cones will be installed at the work sites to ensure road users and pedestrians are well-informed of on-going works. In addition, a 24-hour MRT Ronda will be patrolling along the route to attend to any emergencies.
