MRT Corp expects higher cost for MRT line 2

KUALA LUMPUR: MRT Corp estimates a higher development cost for MRT line 2 at RM28bil from RM23bil due to the longer underground portion.

Its chief executive officer Datuk Seri Shahril Mokhtar said MRT 2's underground length would be around 13.5km compared to the 9.5km in line 1.

MRT 2 that connects Sg Buloh- Serdang-Putrajaya will have an underground portion along Jalan Ipoh to Bandar Malaysia with 11 stations underground.

MRT Line 1 has seven underground stations.
