

MRT CORP CEO THANKS PUBLIC FOR GOOD RESPONSE TO THE SSP LINE PUBLIC INSPECTION

More than 650 people have given their feedback

Kuala Lumpur, 21 May 2015: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd Chief Executive Officer Dato' Sri Shahril Mokhtar said he was very encouraged with the good response to the Sungai Buloh – Serdang – Putrajaya Line (SSP Line) Public Inspection.

"We have received more than 650 feedbacks within one week of the Public Inspection for the SSP Line. Many more people had visited the booths. This is very encouraging and I would like to thank members of the public for this good response," he said.

Shahril was speaking to the media during his visit to the SSP Line Public Inspection booth at the Quill City Mall here today.

Quill City Mall is one of 25 locations for the SSP Line Public Inspection Roadshow. The other Public Inspection booths which are open now are in the Suruhanjaya Pengangkutan Awam Darat (SPAD), Majlis Perbandaran Sepang, Majlis Perbandaran Selayang, and The Mines Shopping Centre.

"I hope more people will come and visit the booth at one of these 24 locations to learn more about the SSP Line and give their views and feedback on the Project. Your feedback is important to us as it will enable us to develop an MRT line which caters to your needs," he said.

As at 9am this morning, 658 feedbacks had been received from visitors to the booths and also via the MRT Project website.

The Public Inspection exercise is a requirement under Section 84 of the Land Public Transport Act 2010. Under the Act, MRT Corp is required to deposit plans, sections and a



book of reference related to the SSP Line with the Suruhanjaya Pengangkutan Awam Darat (SPAD). SPAD then displays these documents for members of the public to inspect.

The booths for the Public Inspection are being set up at local councils, shopping malls, community halls and a hospital, between 15 May 2015 and 17 August 2015 according a roadshow schedule. The schedule of the roadshows attached.

At these booths, members of the public can view boards and materials containing information about the SPP Line. They include satellite images of planned alignment of the 52.2km line and locations of the 36 stations. Other project information such as typical station features and layout, land acquisition plans, railway transit technical data and project construction details.

MRT Corp is also enabling access to the displays via their website, **www.mymrt.com.my**, throughout the period.

The proposed SSP Line is the second of the three intended MRT lines that will complete Klang Valley Mass Rapid Transit (KVMRT) Project.

The planned interconnectivity with existing KTM Komuter LRT, KL Monorail and ERL Transit lines, as well as the Sungai Buloh Kajang Line, will enable residents of the region to have greater urban rail mobility than ever before.

Proper planning and foresight will also enable the SSP Line to integrate with future rail lines such as High Speed Rail, Putrajaya Monorail and MRT Line 3.
