INCIDENT AT MRT PROJECT SITE AT JALAN DUTA

Kuala Lumpur, 9 June 2015: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) wishes to confirm that an incident had occurred involving a member of the public at the MRT Project worksite at Jalan Duta.

Initial reports from witnesses at the site revealed that at about 11:00am, a man, believed to be in his late 30s, was driving a car and was involved in an accident with another vehicle on Jalan Duta outside the MRT work site.

The MRT Project traffic team assisted by moving the two cars to the side of the road. The New Jersey Barriers were moved to enable the cars to not obstruct traffic flow. Both drivers then spoke to each other.

Witness reports claimed that the then person then went to one of the MRT piers and climbed up the scaffolding there. He subsequently jumped from the scaffolding and died.

At the time of the incident, the site was properly cordoned off with New Jersey Barriers. No construction work is being carried out at the location at the time of the incident.

MRT Corp and all other parties involved in the MRT Project will provide Police with the fullest cooperation for investigations into the case.
