## MRT Corp gets more to speak up through #MRTSSPLine contest

*Mass Rapid Transit Corporation (MRT Corp) held a prize draw for its contest organised to heighten awareness of the alignment of the MRT Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya Line, at Avenue K Shopping Mall in Kuala Lumpur today.*

Prizes were presented to 15 winners of the #MRTSSPLine contest, aimed at getting more to participate in the the MRT SSP Line Public Inspection through social media.

“The response has been very good. We were able to get the feedback of more than 6,000 people, while more than 30,000 have visited our public inspection booths since they were launched on May 15,” said MRT strategic communications and public relations director Mahmood Abdul Razak

“We hope that more of the public, especially the online community, will learn of the MRT SSP Line Public Inspection and give their feedback.”

Mahmood said the public inspection was held for the purpose of getting feedback so that the alignment plan could be altered, if necessary, for the better.

“Public feedback is important in determining the final alignment of the SSP line.”

Mahmood said the aim was to get feedback from 10,000 people by Aug 17.

Today’s event saw the end of the second round of the contest which ran from May 8 to June 30. The winners received an iPhone 6, Samsung S6, and an iPad, among other prizes.
