

**PRESS STATEMENT**  
**TACKLING THE FLOOD PROBLEM AT BUKIT DUKUNG**  
**30 DECEMBER 2015**

**Kuala Lumpur, 30 December 2015** – MMC Gamuda KVMRT (PDP) Sdn Bhd would like to clarify that the flooding at Kampung Bukit Dukung (KBD), Kajang, have always been a key concern of PDP and its contractors since the initiation of the Klang Valley MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang Line project.

The area of concern published in the Harian Metro article on 23 December 2015 have been a flood prone area since 1999. It was recently ascertained that the flash flood at KBD is primarily attributed to the old drainage system surrounding the area, as well as rain water runoff from Jalan Cheras Lama. Additionally, the capacity of Anak Sungai Long Kechil river should also be reviewed.

MMC Gamuda KVMRT (PDP) Sdn Bhd and its contractors have been working closely with Majlis Perbandaran Kajang (MPKj) and Jabatan Pengairan Dan Saliran Selangor (JPS) to take comprehensive measures including immediate, short term and long term flood mitigation scheme to curb flooding at KBD. Besides continuously maintaining all drainage outlets within the MRT worksite, to date, one detention pond has been constructed inside the MRT worksite, with another 2 detention ponds under construction to mitigate flooding.

In regards to residents affected by the flood; the Emergency Response Team comprising of workers from the MRT contractors have always been deployed to assist whenever the MRT hotline was contacted.
