MRT CORP AWARDS AUTOMATIC FARE COLLECTION WORK PACKAGE

Kuala Lumpur, 9 September 2016: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) wishes to announce the award of the automatic fare collection (AFC) work package for the MRT Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya (SSP) Line to Indra Sistemas and Rasma Corporation Consortium.

The consortium is made up of the Spanish public-listed multinational consulting and technology company Indra Sistemas S.A. and Malaysian company Rasma Corporation Sdn. Bhd. Indra Sistemas holds 80% equity in the consortium while the remaining 20% is held by Rasma Corporation.

The decision to award Work Package SSP-SY-207 for the engineering, procurement, construction, testing and commissioning of the AFC to the consortium was made following a One-Stop Procurement Committee (OSPC) Meeting chaired by Finance Minister II YB Datuk Johari Abdul Ghani.

The price of the work package is RM152.9 million.

Congratulating the consortium for being the successful tenderer, MRT Corp Chief Executive Officer Dato' Sri Shahril Mokhtar said the AFC is a very important component in the construction of the SSP Line.

"Today's award is significant as it marks another step forward in the development of the Klang Valley MRT Project's second MRT line. Also, this is the last of the seven systems work packages to be successfully awarded for the SSP Line," he said.

Shahril said the successful tenderer was among five consortiums that participated in the tender for the work package.

He said the basis for selecting the successful tenderer is the Best Evaluated Tender, which comprises both the technical and commercial scores. In view of this, the successful tender may not necessary be that of the lowest price.

"However, I am pleased to say that for this tender, the successful tenderer also quoted the lowest price," he said.

The AFC system comprises all software inclusive of all necessary licenses, fare medias, AFC central computer, station accounting computers, automatic fare gates, ticket vending machines, office ticket processor, cash handling system and other related works.



The system will also be integrated with the Integrated Cashless Payment System for the Klang Valley's public transport system.

With this award, the number of work packages which have been awarded by MRT Corp for the SSP Line now stands at 23.

They comprise eight advance work packages, four viaduct work packages, one underground works package, seven systems work packages, two designated supplier work packages and one depot work package.
