MRT CORP AWARDS TWO VIADUCT WORK PACKAGES

Kuala Lumpur, 9 November 2016: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) wishes to announce the award of two viaduct work package contracts for the construction of the MRT Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya (SSP) Line.

Work Package V204 for the construction and completion of the viaduct guideway and other associated works from Bandar Malaysia South Portal to Kampung Muhibbah was awarded to WCT Berhad. The contract sum is RM896.41 million.

The tender for Work Package V204, which is in the open category, commenced on 2 June 2016 and closed on 16 August 2016. A total of six companies had submitted tenders.

Meanwhile, the successful tenderer for Work Package V208 for the construction and completion of the viaduct guideway and other associated works from Taman Pinggiran Putra to Persiaran Alpina was MTD Construction Sdn Bhd. The contract sum is RM678.68 million.

The tender for Work Package V208 was an open tender for Bumiputera companies, which commenced on 28 June 2016 and closed on 6 September 2016. A total of three tenders were submitted for this work package.

The award for the two packages were made following a One-Stop Procurement Meeting chaired by Prime Minister Dato' Sri Mohd Najib Tun Abdul Razak.

MRT Corp Chief Executive Officer Dato' Sri Shahril Mokhtar welcomed the two successful contractors, saying that their involvement would bode well for the MRT Project.

"The two contractors are well known in the construction industry due to their track record. This is a boon for the project as their experience will benefit the construction of the SSP Line," he said.

He added that MRT Corp was already familiar with MTD Construction as they were also a work package contractor for the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang Line. MTD Construction



handled Work Package V7 for the construction of the guideway between Bandar Tun Hussein Onn and Taman Mesra near Kajang.

Shahril said the both the successful tenderers were selected on the basis of the best evaluated tender, where the tenders were evaluated on their technical as well as their commercial submissions.

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
