

Use TnG during peak hours, commuters told

KUALA LUMPUR — Commuters have been advised to use MyRapid Touch 'n Go cards during peak hours after several of Rapid KL's token vending machines (TVMs) were reportedly malfunctioning.

Dismissing claims that its TVMs at Sungai Buloh MRT station were not working and had resulted in long queues, Rapid KL said the queues were because of the overwhelming response for the MRT service, and the machines were in working order.

“The rakyat has come out to Klang Valley to enjoy the special experience riding on the MRT. We would like to record our highest appreciation and thanks for the support,” the statement reads.

Rapid KL said the tokens at the machines needed to be replenished and that would need some time because of the high turnout of commuters at the station.

It said commuters were advised to utilise cashless mode of travelling by using TnG cards that were compatible with all Rapid KL travel networks in order to save time and skip the queues.
