Mufti: MRT project shows govt has fulfilled duty

KAJANG: The successful implementation of the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang line is proof that the government has fulfilled its duty to Malaysians.

Federal Territories Mufti Datuk Dr Zulkifli Mohamad al-Bakri said that from the Islamic perspective, the government had carried out its responsibility by implementing the world-class project.

“From the religious (Islamic) perspective, such infrastructure and facilities are part of the people’s inalienable rights, which the government is obligated to fulfil,” he said after boarding the train from Stadium Kajang station to the Tun Razak Exchange stop with an entourage of about 30 ulama and umara.

He said this was, among others, because the facilities were cost

effective and saved time and money.

Zulkifli also said it allowed people to travel in relative stress-free conditions and spend the time saved with family.
