

# Netizens lavish praise on girl who wipes clean soda stain

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Another Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) commuter has attracted public attention for her behaviour, but this time, for the right reasons.

Commuter Mohd Faiz Muhamad Daud shared the story of a civic-minded passenger in a Facebook post recently.

In his post, Faiz related an in-

cident where a passenger spilled his carbonated drink on the floor of an MRT coach. Fortunately, he was conscientious enough to wipe the spilled water off before disembarking from the train.

"The passenger immediately wiped and cleaned the (floor) before (getting off) at his destination.

"But what was unexpected was a young girl who (used) tissue paper to (give the floor a thorough cleaning). I did not expect her to do that and asked her why she cleaned it again when the earlier passenger had already (done so).

"She said (since it was a soda drink), it would leave a sticky stain if not wiped properly.

"Respect this girl," Faiz posted, with a picture of the girl wiping the floor.

He said he could only speak briefly with the girl, a student whose name was Angeline.

"This girl should be given the highest appreciation, as not many would do what she did," he said yesterday.

The post received more than 15,000 likes and 1,960 shares as at 2pm yesterday.

Some have even tagged Rapid KL's Facebook page in the comment box to acknowledge Angeline's deed.

Many have voiced their appreciation to the girl and are exhorting the public to follow her example.
