



1. The Kuala Lumpur International Airport in Sepang. Malaysia's main international airport began its operation in June 1988.

2. Malaysia Airlines Bhd, the country's flag carrier, first flew its commercial flight in 1947 as Malayan Airways.

3. A Keretapi Tanah Melayu railway crossing at Jalan Genuang in Johor in 1981.

4. The Penang Bridge was officially opened to the public on Sept 14, 1985, linking the Penang Island to Butterworth on the mainland.

5. A telecommunication shop at Taman Rasa Sayang in Petaling Jaya, Selangor, in 1982. The shop provides services for people to send telegrams, use the telephone and pay phone bills.

6. The second phase of the Mass Rapid Transit Sungai Buloh-Kajang line was launched on July 17, 2017.

7. Malaysia People's Housing Programme (PRIMA) was launched July 4, 2011. PRIMA projects provide affordable housing for Malaysians earning RM2,500 and RM15,000 a month.

8. Port of Tanjung Pelepas is Malaysia's biggest single port operator.

9. The MRT project included feeder buses that complement the rail service.
