

RM177.4m contracts for TRC Synergy

KUALA LUMPUR: TRC Synergy Bhd has clinched RM177.4 million worth of contracts related to the mass rapid transit (MRT) lines.

In a filing with Bursa Malaysia yesterday, TRC Synergy said its wholly-owned subsidiary Trans Resources Corp Sdn Bhd last Thursday and yesterday accepted the awards from Mass Rapid Transit Corp Sdn Bhd for the works.

The first contract involves the construction of the Pasar Seni paid link between the existing Pasar Seni LRT station and the Kuala Lumpur KTM station for the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang

line for RM103.8 million.

The other RM74.4 million contract encompasses renovation and conservation works to Block A and Block C of Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad, including relocation of the Craft museum to Block C of Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad, relocation of the “Karyaneka” craft boutique and souvenir shops to Block A of Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad, as well as relocation of the craft village and artist village to Dataran Underground for MRT Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya Line 2.

TRC Synergy said the projects will contribute positively to the earnings and earnings per share of TRC Group in the future.
