

TRC Synergy wins MRT construction contracts

PETALING JAYA: TRC Synergy Bhd has been awarded two Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) related construction contracts with a total value of RM178.2 million.

In a filing with the stock exchange, the company said its wholly-owned subsidiary Trans Resources Corp Sdn Bhd had on March 24 and 28 accepted the awards from MRT Corp Sdn Bhd.

The first RM103.8 million contract is for the construction works for the link between the existing Pasar Seni LRT station and Kuala Lumpur KTM station for the MRT line 1 (Sungai Buloh-Kajang).

Meanwhile, under the package B job for the MRT line 2 project (Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya), TRC Synergy is to undertake renovation and conservation works for Block A and C of the Sultan Abdul Samad building for RM74.4 million.

Barring unforeseen circumstances, the TRC board says the projects will contribute positively to the group's earnings and earnings per share in the future.
