NOTICE OF TENDER

Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd ("MRT Corp.") is a wholly-owned Malaysian Government company established by the Ministry of Finance to facilitate, undertake and expedite public infrastructure project approved by the Government. The Malaysian Government has appointed **MRT Corp.** as the MRT Project Owner and MMC-Gamuda KVMRT (PDP) Sdn Bhd as the Project Delivery Partner ("**PDP**") who is responsible for the delivery of a fully commissioned MRT system known as "PROJEK MASS RAPID TRANSIT LALUAN 2: SUNGAI BULOH – SERDANG - PUTRAJAYA (SSP)". SSP project is the second line of the MRT infrastructure, and will form an integral component of a railway network which will be the backbone of the Klang Valley's public transportation system to meet the needs of the *Rakyat*. Its seamless connection will be able to contribute towards making Kuala Lumpur a world-class city, supporting its growth and enhancing *Rakyat* productivity.

4. Tender Documents shall only be sold to Tenderers who attended the tender briefing. MRT Corp. **SHALL NOT** entertain any requisition for the purchase of Tender Documents before and/or after the time as stipulated.
5. The Tender Documents will only be sold to a "bona fide" representative of the Tenderers. For this purpose, a **Letter of Authorisation** to purchase the Tender Documents **MUST** be produced by Tenderers' representative together with valid '**ORIGINAL**' and '**CERTIFIED TRUE COPY**' (certified by the **Company Secretary or Group A Government Servant**) of the relevant registration certificates of "**Perakuan Pendaftaran Kontraktor (PPK)**", **Sijil Perolehan Kerja Kerajaan (SPKK)** from **CIDB** to confirm the Tenderers' qualification.
6. All Tenderers shall observe and comply with statutory requirements, rules and regulations, including any modifications to it or re-enactment that is enforced by the Government of Malaysia.
