Bidders that meet the following criteria are invited to submit duly completed RFP documents

- Sound financial capacity with minimum paid up capital of **Ringgit Malaysia: One Million (RM1 Million)**
- The Bidding Company is required to submit their past 3 years audited account and the shareholder's fund must be positive within the period stated.
- The Bidding Company is capable of undertaking the licensing fee within the period that the Bidder is bidding.
- The Bidding Company is carrying out legal business activities, no criminal records or civil court cases; and that the brand that will appear as prefix to the station is of positive, healthy and socially responsible image.

Notes:

- Bidders are invited from Companies registered with and under the specified registration details as per the above table, which is still valid at this point of bidding.
- Bidders are required to attend a **COMPULSORY** RFP briefing and site visit as per detail above.
- The RFP Documents will be displayed and made available for purchase from the date, time and location specified in the above table. Bidders can view the RFP Documents prior to purchase.
- Licensee under the Station Naming Right will have the rights for Prefixed the Station Name e.g. "Brand Name/Company [XYZ]"; where XYZ is the name of the selected station. More information can be obtained from RFP Document and MRT's official website www.mymrt.com.my
- RFP Documents shall only be sold to Bidders who attended the RFP briefing. MRT Corp **SHALL NOT** entertain any request for the purchase of RFP Documents before and/or after the time stipulated.
