The Government of Malaysia had also appointed MMC GAMUDA KVMRT (PDP) SDN BHD (927050-H) as the Project Delivery Partner which is responsible for the delivery of a fully operational MRT line known as the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang Line (SBK Line).

Positive net profit over such three (3) year period	a. the Proponent shall have a minimum of three (3) years' experience in deploying and managing telecommunication infrastructure and services for major railway operators mainly to perform physical equipment installation, operation and maintenance at tunnels, track/wayside, trains and at stations; b. the Proponent shall have a minimum of three (3) years' experience in deploying, managing and commercialising public Wi-Fi services and its related systems; c. the Proponent must have secured contracts to design, build, operate and manage telecommunication infrastructure and services with at least one (1) MRT/LRT/railway operator in Malaysia; and d. the Proponent must have secured contracts to design, build, operate and manage telecommunication infrastructure and services with at least three (3) major telecommunication providers in Malaysia.

- Bidders are invited from experienced Companies/Consortiums/Joint Ventures registered with and under the specified registration details as per the above table, which is still valid and allowed to bid at this point of bidding.
- Bidders are required to attend a **COMPULSORY** RFP briefing as per detail above.
