ALL ELEVATED STATION CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS FOR SSP LINE AWARDED

Kuala Lumpur, 6 November 2017: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) wishes to announce that all work packages for the construction of elevated stations for the MRT Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya (SSP) Line have been successfully awarded.

Six elevated station work packages, with a total value of RM 1.23 billion, were awarded during One Stop Procurement Committee (OSPC) meetings held in September and October which were chaired by Minister of Finance II Datuk Seri Johari Abdul Ghani.

All station work packages of the project are nominated sub-contracts of their corresponding viaduct packages.

Work package S204 for the construction and completion of elevated stations and other associated works at Kuchai Lama and Taman Naga Emas was awarded to WCT Berhad. The contract sum was RM199.5 million.

The tender was in the open category and a total of six companies, including WCT Berhad, submitted tenders.

Last year, WCT Berhad was awarded the corresponding viaduct work package V204 for the construction of the viaduct guideway and other associated works from Bandar Malaysia South Portal to Kampung Muhibbah.

Meanwhile, work package S205 for the construction and completion of elevated stations and other associated works at Sungai Besi and Serdang Raya North was awarded to Apex Communication Sdn Bhd. The contract sum is RM243.34 million.

The tender for this work package is in the Bumiputera Category and Apex beat two other companies to emerge as the successful tenderer for this work package.

Apex had also been awarded several work packages for the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang (SBK) Line, including two elevated station work packages S7 and S8.



The work package contractor for the corresponding viaduct work package V205 for the construction and completion of the viaduct guideway and other associated works from Kampung Muhibbah to Serdang Raya, is Trans Resources Corporation Bhd which was awarded the contract in March this year.

Package S206 for the construction and completion of elevated stations and other associated works at Serdang Raya South, Seri Kembangan and UPM was awarded to Ahmad Zaki Sdn Bhd. The contract sum is RM 288.47 million.

The tender is in the Bumiputera category and a total of five companies, including the successful tenderer, had submitted tenders.

The corresponding viaduct work package V206 for the construction and completion of the viaduct guideway and other associated works from Serdang Raya to UPM was awarded to Gadang Engineering (M) Sdn Bhd in March this year.

In April 2016, Ahmad Zaki was awarded the work package V202 for the construction and completion of the viaduct guideway and other associated works from Persiaran Dagang to Jinjang.

The company was also involved in the construction of the SBK Line where it was awarded the viaduct work package V6 and also station work package S6.

Station work package S208 for the construction and completion of elevated stations and other associated works at Equine Park and Taman Putra Permai was awarded to S.N. Akmida Sdn Bhd. The contract sum is RM219.7 million.

The tender was in the Bumiputera category and a total of four companies, including S.N. Akmida, had submitted tenders.

The corresponding viaduct work package V208 for the construction and completion of the viaduct guideway and other associated works from Taman Pinggiran Putra to Persiaran Alpina was awarded to MTD Construction Sdn Bhd in November 2016.

This is the second station work package awarded to S.N. Akmida for the SSP Line. Last year, MRT Corp awarded station work package S202 for the construction and completion of elevated stations and other associated works at Kepong Sentral, Metro Prima, Kepong Baru and Jinjang to the company.

Meanwhile, station work package S209 for the construction and completion of elevated stations and other associated works at 16 Sierra and Cyberjaya North was awarded to Acre Works Sdn Bhd. The contract sum is RM137.9 million.



Acre Works is also the contractor for the corresponding viaduct work package V209 for the construction and completion of the viaduct guideway and other associated works from Persiaran Alpinia to Persiaran Apec.

The tender for station work package S209 was in the Bumiputera category and a total of six companies had submitted tenders.

Acre Works is also involved in other works for the SSP Line, including the advance work for the design and build contract for the new JKR Wilayah Persekutuan Workshop as well as the supply and delivery of segmental box girders under Package SBG202.

Finally, Malaysian Resources Corporation Berhad (MRCB) emerged as the successful tenderer for station works package S210 for the construction and completion of elevated stations and other associated works at Cyberjaya City Centre and Putrajaya Sentral. The contract sum is RM145.8 million.

The tender is in the Bumiputera category, and a total five companies had submitted tenders.

MRCB is also the work package contractor for the corresponding viaduct work package V210 for the construction and completion of the viaduct guideway and other associated works from Persiaran APEC to Putrajaya Sentral. This work package was awarded in May 2016.

Elevated station work packages S201, S202 and S203 had been awarded at the end of last year and earlier this year. The construction of underground stations comes under the scope of work of the Underground Works Package which was also awarded last year.

There is also no elevated station work package S207 as the station under the corresponding viaduct work package V207 is a provisional station which would only be built in the future.

Besides the above station work packages, other work packages had also awarded.

Global Rail Dom Industries (BMS201) Joint Venture was awarded Package BMS201 for the Design, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of the Building Management System for Elevated (V201 to V210) and Depot (DPT201). The contract sum is RM39.89 million.

The tender is in the open category, and a total of six companies had submitted tenders including the winning tenderer.

Work Package L&E 202 for the Supply, Procurement, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of Lifts and Escalator Systems for Elevated Stations and Depot was divided



into two groups, with Group A covering packages V203 (part of), V204, V205 and V206, and Group B covering packages V208, V209, V210 and DPT210.

The successful tenderer for Group A was Eita Elevator (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd for a contract sum of RM69.83 million, while the successful tenderer for Group B was Rani-MS Engineering Sdn Bhd for a contract sum of RM42.92 million.

The work package is in the open category and a total of five companies had submitted tenders for both groups.

Meanwhile, Package L&E 201 for the Supply, Procurement, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of Lifts and Escalator Systems for Elevated Stations (Package V201, V202 and Part of V203) was awarded to Rani-MS Engineering Sdn Bhd. The contract sum is RM73.38 million.

The tender is in the open category, and Rani-MS Engineering beat two other companies to win the tender.

A summary of the awards is appended with this media release.

MRT Corp Chief Executive Officer Dato' Sri Shahril Mokhtar congratulated the successful tenderers, and welcomed a number of companies that were already very familiar with the Klang Valley MRT project.

"I wish to welcome back a number of companies which have been with us since the SBK Line.

"For companies which have just gotten on board, the Klang Valley MRT Project sets a high benchmark in the construction industry. I hope you will be able to learn quickly as you carry out your tasks with close guidance from MRT Corp and the Project Delivery Partner," said Shahril.

Shahril added that the successful tenderers were selected on the basis of the best evaluated tender, where the tenders were evaluated on their technical, commercial, legal, financial and Industrial Collaboration Programme evaluation.

The construction of the MRT SSP Line was launched by the Prime Minister YAB Dato' Sri Mohd Najib Tun Abdul Razak on 16 September 2016. The First Phase of the SSP Line will be operational by July 2021, and is expected to be completed by July 2022.
