MRT CORP CEO TO STEP DOWN

Kuala Lumpur, 17 December 2018: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) wishes to announce that Chief Executive Officer Dato' Sri Shahril Mokhtar will be stepping down at the end of the year.

Shahril, who took over the helm of the owner and developer of the Klang Valley MRT Project on 5 January 2015, will not be extending his contract when it concludes on 31 December 2018.

The decision was made based on his desire to pursue other career options.

Shahril said it had been an honour for him to have been given the opportunity to serve in MRT Corp and drive the construction of the KVMRT Project.

"I will cherish every moment I had with MRT Corp, especially the highlights such as the opening for the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang Line, Malaysia's first MRT line, and the commencement of work of the MRT Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya Line," he said.

The MRT Corp Board of Directors which met on 14 December 2018 decided to appoint MRT Corp Director of Strategic Communications and Stakeholder Relations, Dato' Najmuddin Abdullah as Acting Chief Executive Officer. He will act in the position until a new CEO is appointed by the Government.
