

**TRANSEAT – MRT PUTRAJAYA LINE UNDERGROUND STATIONS
BENCH DESIGN COMPETITION
TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

A. GENERAL

1. Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd ("MRT Corp") is organising the "Transeat: MRT Putrajaya Line Underground Stations Bench Design Competition" ("The Competition") which runs over a period of sixty one (61) days from **1 June 2020 until 31 July 2020** (both dates inclusive).

B. ELIGIBILITY

1. The Competition is open to all Malaysian citizens ("Participants").
2. Employees of Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd, MMC Gamuda KVMRT (PDP SSP) Sdn Bhd and MMC Gamuda KVMRT (T) Sdn Bhd are not eligible to participate in this competition.

C. SUBMISSION

1. Submissions will be sent using the Entry Form via email to **transeat@mymrt.com.my**
2. Entries for each submission should comprise the following:
 - a. 1 x A1-sized image board in PDF format containing:
 - 3D views
 - Design statement summary
 - Plan, elevations and sections (1: 10 scale) with dimensions
 - Material specifications
 - Additional drawings of special features and/or blow-up details if present
 - b. 1 x A3-sized report in landscape orientation in PDF format containing:
 - Page 1: One 3D overall view
 - Page 2: Design Statement - written description of the bench design proposal demonstrating how it complements with the station architectural



design concept, identity theme and colour, artistic approach and aesthetic appeal

- Page 3: 3D views
 - Page 4: Plans, top views and elevations from all four sides with dimensions
 - Page 5: Additional drawings (to scale) with description of special features and/or blow-up details
 - Page 6: Technical details – materials, finishing, ergonomics, construction technique, colours, etc.
 - Page 7: Estimated preliminary cost of fabrication
- c. 1 x compressed softcopy files containing:
- PDF file of A1 -sized image board
 - PDF file of A3-sized report
 - High-resolution image files of all 3D views used in the submission
3. Entries will be evaluated and shortlisted to go for next round of evaluation process. The shortlisted entries will be required to submit:
- Submission in soft copy file for printing of 1 x 3D working model (1:5 scale model)
4. All submissions must be in either Bahasa Malaysia or English.
5. Multiple submissions of different works by Participants are acceptable.
6. Submissions by individuals are encouraged. Group submissions are permitted but a group must not comprise of more than 3 individuals and the submission should be under the name of the group. Should a group submission be selected as a winner, only a single prize will be awarded to the group.
7. All submitted work must be the original work of the Participants and must not include, be based on or derived from any pre-existing or third-party designs, trademarks or copyrighted images. All concepts, text, icons, sheets, pictures, videos, audios, music, animation contents and program of the work shall not be involved in any plagiarism or infringement of copyrights or other laws.
8. Participants shall cooperate with MRT Corp's request in connection with the competition and the fabrication of any prototypes or benches. The Participants shall



execute any additional documentation that MRT Corp reasonably determines to be necessary to allow for its use in whole or any part of any design submitted entry.

9. Unsuccessful submissions can be taken back by Participants within one (1) month after the announcement of winners. Any unclaimed submission after that period will be disposed.
10. Any submission made before or after the Competition Period will be ineligible.
11. MRT Corp reserves its absolute right and discretion to accept and/or reject any participation submitted for the Competition if, in its opinion, the participation is not valid and/or false and/or contains inaccurate information and/or the participants is ineligible to participate.
12. MRT Corp reserves the right to change/cancel the Competition without prior notification. For the avoidance of doubt, cancellation, termination or suspension by MRT Corp shall not entitle the Participants to any claim or compensation against MRT Corp for any and all losses or damages suffered or incurred as a direct or indirect result of the act of cancellation, termination or suspension. MRT Corp has no obligation to proceed with any stage of the competition, including the selection of finalists or winners, or exhibit any prototypes.
13. All expenditure related to the submission of entries or any other aspect of the participant's participation in the competition are the sole responsibility of the participant.

D. SELECTION OF WINNERS AND PRIZES

1. The submission will be evaluated based on the followings;
 - a. Compliance to submission requirements and design requirements
 - b. Adoption of design considerations
2. The judging process will be as follows:
 - a. Stage 1 – Each submission will be evaluated. Top 10 submissions with highest score will be shortlisted for Stage 2 evaluation.
 - b. Stage 2 – The shortlisted submissions will be further evaluated for selection of the winner.



3. A total of four (4) Winners will be selected during the Competition Period as follows:
 - a. Grand Prize: RM10,000.00
 - b. First Runner-Up Prize: RM7,000.00
 - c. Second Runner-Up Prize: RM5,000.00
 - d. Special Prize (Best submission by student): RM5,000.00
4. Prizes are not transferable and are not exchangeable for any other item, in part or in full.
5. A total of four (4) Winners shall receive the prize at his/her own risk and will accept the prize as it is.
6. Participants shall respect the evaluation and decisions made by the committee. The decision of the judges of the Competition will be final.
7. Prize winners shall be present at the prize award ceremony organised by MRT Corp. All travel expenses related to the award ceremony will be borne by the participants.
8. Requests, lobbies, threats, bribes or other actions interfering in the evaluation are not allowed.
9. MRT Corp reserves its absolute right to substitute any of the prizes with another prize of equivalent value, at any time, without giving prior notice or without assigning any reason whatsoever to the winners.
10. To the extent permitted by law, MRT Corp makes no warranties, representations or endorsements, expressed or implied, written or oral, including but not limited to, any warranty of quality, merchantability or suitability or fitness for a particular purpose of the prizes and MRT Corp shall not be responsible nor liable for any problems, loss and/or damage thereto or arising therefrom. Any dispute in relation to the prizes must be settled between the winner and the supplier or manufacturer. MRT Corp will not be responsible for resolving such disputes and the winners are to liaise directly with the supplier or manufacturer for warranty information pertaining to the prizes.



E. CONSENT

1. Participants shall agree to provide further details or information about their entries for media coverage and exhibitions in connection or otherwise with the competition at the request of MRT Corp.
2. MRT Corp reserves the right to use all entries (including the photographs and written descriptions of the entries) for promotional purposes, including for the current or future competitions, in any way deemed fit and at the sole discretion of MRT Corp.
3. Except where prohibited by law, an entry submission in this contest constitutes the granting of permission to use, in connection with the competition, the participant's name and likeness and any other information that the participant provides to MRT Corp in connection with the competition, including in credits for top designs, prototypes, and winning design for publicity purposes, without further permission or compensation.

F. DESIGN

1. The mandatory design requirements the Participants must comply with are as follows:
 - a. Capacity and Dimensions
 - Each bench to accommodate three (3) persons
 - Length of bench not to exceed two meters (2m)
 - Sitting surface shall be between 400 millimeters (400mm) to 500 millimeters (500mm) high from finished floor level
 - b. Functional Configuration
 - Bench to be fixed to platform floor
 - Ergonomic, inclusive and user –friendly
 - Bench shall take into consideration public safety and avoid sharp edges
 - Vandalism prevention methods shall be holistically integrated with the design
 - Bench shall be designed to discourage people from lying down



- Flexible seating arrangement on the bench (single-facing, back-to-back and multi-directional are acceptable)
- c. Material Selection
- Non-combustible and low heat emission
 - Ease of maintenance
 - Robust and vandal resistant
2. The following are design considerations which the Participants can based on:
- a. Concept and design innovation
- Cohesiveness to linewide identity, creativity, originality, material selection, technology and construction.
- b. Design functionality
- Ease of maintenance, safety, inclusivity and ergonomics.
- c. Vandalism prevention ideas
- Holistic integration with design
- d. Cost effectiveness
- Overall consideration of the material, fabrication and maintenance cost. Estimated preliminary cost of bench fabrication shall be included in the submission.
3. The winning designs shall become the property of MRT Corp. By entering this competition, each participant agrees that all intellectual property rights pertaining to his or her design shall be deemed assigned to MRT Corp upon the design being selected as a winning design.
4. MRT Corp reserves the right to modify the winning design to better fit the needs of the MRT project.
5. MRT Corp reserves the right not to adopt or use any winning design or any design submitted for the competition without giving any reason to the participants.
6. MRT Corp shall not be held liable and responsible for any damage, claims or loss of ideas before or after the competition.



G. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. By participating in this Competition, the Participants are deemed to have read, understood and agreed to the Terms and Conditions stipulated herein and will abide by all decisions made by MRT Corp.
2. MRT Corp will not be responsible or liable for any problem, error, loss or damage of whatsoever nature suffered by the Participants due to any delay and/or failure in receiving and sending the entry form as a result of any network, communication or system error, interruption, omission and/or resulting from participation in the Competition.
3. The results once announced are final and binding. The decisions of MRT Corp in relation to every aspect of the Competition, including but not limited to the type of prize and the winners, shall be deemed final and conclusive under any and all circumstances. No appeal, challenge, query or complaint from any of the Participants will be entertained. The receipt by any winner of any prize under the Competition is conditional upon compliance with any and all applicable laws, rules and regulations.
4. MRT Corp reserves the right at its absolute discretion to vary, delete or add to any of these Terms and Conditions contained herein wholly or in part. MRT Corp may terminate or extend the Competition Period without prior notice to the Participants.
5. These Terms and Conditions shall prevail over any representations contained in any promotional materials (including without limitation printed posters or leaflets) or advertisements on the Competition.
6. Any matter with regards to the Competition which is not covered in these Terms and Conditions will be determined solely by MRT Corp at its discretion.
7. MRT Corp, its related corporations, directors, officers, employees or agents will not be liable for any loss (including direct, indirect, special and consequential losses), damage, or any injury that may be sustained by the Participant or by any person in connection with the Contest. All Participants assume liability for any loss, injury, damage or claim that may arise from participating in the Competition or use of any prize.



8. Any federal, state and local taxes that may be imposed in connection with the prizes are the sole responsibility of the winners.
9. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Malaysia. You agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Malaysia.
