

## NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (“RFI”) FOR MRT3 CIRCLE LINE PROJECT

The Government of Malaysia has appointed MASS RAPID TRANSIT CORPORATION SDN BHD (902884V) (MRT Corp.) as the MRT Project Developer and Asset Owner for the delivery of a fully commissioned metro rail system known as “PROJEK MASS RAPID TRANSIT LALUAN 3: LALUAN LINGKARAN”.

**PROJEK MASS RAPID TRANSIT LALUAN 3: LALUAN LINGKARAN** (“MRT3 Circle Line”) is part of the Greater Kuala Lumpur/Klang Valley Land Transport Masterplan and will interchange existing radial railway lines in Klang Valley. Its function is to distribute passengers throughout existing KL transit systems and acts as terminal nodes and promotes green mobility in Kuala Lumpur City Centre.

Preceding to the above subject matter, MRT Corp. is in the process of gathering information and responses from interested companies via a Request for Information (RFI) exercise. This exercise will allow MRT Corp to fully consider all potential participants (“Participants”) of this project and review the interest, capacity, and capability of the industry to participate in any future tender exercise relating to this project.

A briefing session (RFI Briefing) will be held for interested parties who meet the compulsory requirements and Participants will be required to pre-register to attend this briefing. Details of the RFI briefing session is provided below.

Please be advised that this is NOT an invitation to bid but strictly a ‘Request for Information’ exercise. Neither this request nor your reply or submission constitutes any commitment on our behalf to include you in any future tender exercises.

All information provided, responses and correspondences relating to the ‘Request for Information’ will be kept CONFIDENTIAL. All RFI document submissions will be reviewed on the basis of content, completeness and quality of information provided.

Succesfully completed or currently constructing at least one (1) railway (MRT/LRT/ERL/Double Track Projects) / elevated / bridge / highway project over the last **ten (10) years** of a minimum value of **Ringgit Malaysia: Five Hundred Million (RM500 Million)** in a single project.  
[A certified true copy (certified by the Company’s Secretary or the Company’s Director) of the Letter of Award should be provided as evidence]

The RFI Document will be provided to the participating company without charge after the RFI briefing session is conducted, via the registered email address.

The RFI Responses required are separated into two (2) parts namely PART 1 and PART 2. Submission dates for the RFI responses are as below:

- PART 1: not later than 12.00 noon on Friday, 7 May 2021**
- PART 2: not later than 12.00 noon on Tuesday, 25 May 2021**

Participants are required to submit the duly completed RFI Document with all comprehensive supporting information in the format and method as explained in the RFI Document.

**Additional Information and Notes:**

- Experienced Contractors that possess valid registrations as required in this RFI Requirements and having track record as stated above are invited to participate in this RFI exercise.
- Participants must be locally incorporated Malaysian companies and comply with Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM) incorporation requirements.
- Attendance to the RFI briefing session as detailed above is **COMPULSORY**.
- All Participants in participating this RFI exercise shall observe and comply with the statutory requirements, rules and regulations, including any modifications or re-enactment that is enforced by the Government of Malaysia.
