## MRT CORP TO REVIEW NEW TRAFFIC SYSTEM AT TAMAN SALAK SELATAN

**Kuala Lumpur, 28 September 2021:** Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) refers to media reports regarding the permanent closure of the direct access to Jalan Hang Tuah 4 in Taman Salak Selatan from the Sungai Besi Expressway.

MRT Corp understands the grievances raised by the residents of Taman Salak Selatan and Taman Naga Emas regarding the closure of the access to Jalan Hang Tuah 4 from the Sungai Besi Expressway.

The construction of the new Taman Naga Emas MRT Station of the MRT Putrajaya Line had resulted in the need to introduce a new traffic system in the area which resulted in the closure of this direct access.

However, in view of the issues highlighted by the residents, MRT Corp will now conduct a review of the new traffic system. MRT Corp will seek to engage with traffic experts and relevant authorities, including the Malaysian Highway Authority and Kuala Lumpur City Hall, for the review process.

While the review is being carried out, MRT Corp appeals to road users in the area to abide by the new traffic system that is being implemented for now as it had been approved by the authorities. Road users are advised to drive carefully as they approach the area and follow all road signage.

MRT Corp, MMC Gamuda KVMRT (PDP SSP) Sdn Bhd as the turnkey contractor of the MRT Putrajaya Line, and WCT Construction Sdn Bhd as the work package contractor, will continuously engage with the residents of the area and provide updates with regard to the review of the new traffic system.

MRT Corp wishes to state that it places utmost importance to the safety of all road users, including those from the neighbourhood, Sungai Besi Expressway users and also users of the new MRT station in the design of the new traffic system for the area.
