TECHNICAL CRITERIA (MANDATORY)	
1.	Proponents shall have completed at least one (1) Supervising Consultant Services along a Railway or Elevated Highway with a value of not less than Ringgit Malaysia: One Hundred Fifty Thousand (RM150,000.00) for the past ten (10) years.
FINANCIAL CRITERIA (MANDATORY)	
1.	Average consecutive three (3) months Bank Balance must be positive.
