

PUBLIC INSPECTION REVISED RAILWAY SCHEME PENANG LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT (LRT) MUTIARA LINE

The revised railway scheme reflects the updates to the Penang LRT Mutiara Line project.
The key changes and amended scope are summarised as follows:

- A connection between Penang Island and Seberang Perai, comprising a 6.0 kilometre route from Macallum to Penang Sentral, to be developed as a cross-sea rail link.
- Addition of stations at Penang Sentral and at Bagan Luar (provisional).
- Addition of a secondary depot at Tapak Pesta in Sungai Dua, primarily for the stabling of trains.
- Following the scaling down of the Penang South Reclamation (PSR) development from three islands to one, a total of 3.15 kilometres of alignment and three stations (A2, A3 and A4) have been omitted.
- 1.5 kilometres of the alignment has been retained and Station A1 (PSR A) has been reclassified as a provisional station to support future development as and when the population grows.

PUBLIC INSPECTION

The Mutiara Line LRT project covers a total alignment of 29.67 kilometres with 20 strategically planned stations (plus 2 provisional stations) to create seamless connectivity between key destinations such as Penang International Airport, Bayan Lepas Free Industrial Zone, George Town City Centre and Penang Sentral. Construction has commenced in 2025, with rail services expected to begin operations in December 2031.

In accordance with Section 85 of the Land Public Transport Act 2010, the Public Inspection for the Revised Penang LRT Penang Mutiara Line will be conducted as follows:
