- Participants are invited from Companies registered with specified registration details as per above table and is still valid.
- Single entity participation is allowed.
- Joint venture participation shall be limited to a single formation of a Joint Venture or Consortium consisting of only two (2) companies.
- Foreign company participation shall only be permitted through a joint venture (JV) arrangement with a Malaysian company as the majority shareholder.
- Proponents participating as a JV/Consortium must submit the JV or Consortium Agreement together with their RFP proposal. The agreement must clearly state the leading partner, equity participation of all the members and a "Jointly and Severally Liable" clause by all members of the JV/Consortium. Proponents are not allowed to change JV/Consortium Partners after the RFP closing date.
- The bidding Company/Consortium/JV must be capable of undertaking a DBOT Agreement for a period of **SEVEN (7) years**.
- A Proponent is allowed to submit one (1) submission for each RFP package only, either as a single entity or as a JV/Consortium partner.
- All Participants must observe and comply with statutory requirements, rules and regulations, including any modifications to it or re-enactment that is enforced by the Government of Malaysia.
- MRT Corp reserves the right to accept or reject any proposal from any Participants without assigning any reason and without incurring any liability of whatsoever nature to the affected Participants or any obligation to inform the affected Participants of the grounds for such decision.
