Untuk makluman, penutupan separa lorong jangka panjang di Jalan Sultan Azlan Shah (kedua-dua arah) akan dilaksanakan selama 24 jam sehari, bermula 1 Ogos 2026 hingga 1 Ogos 2029, selama 1096 hari.

Pelan pengurusan trafik adalah seperti berikut:

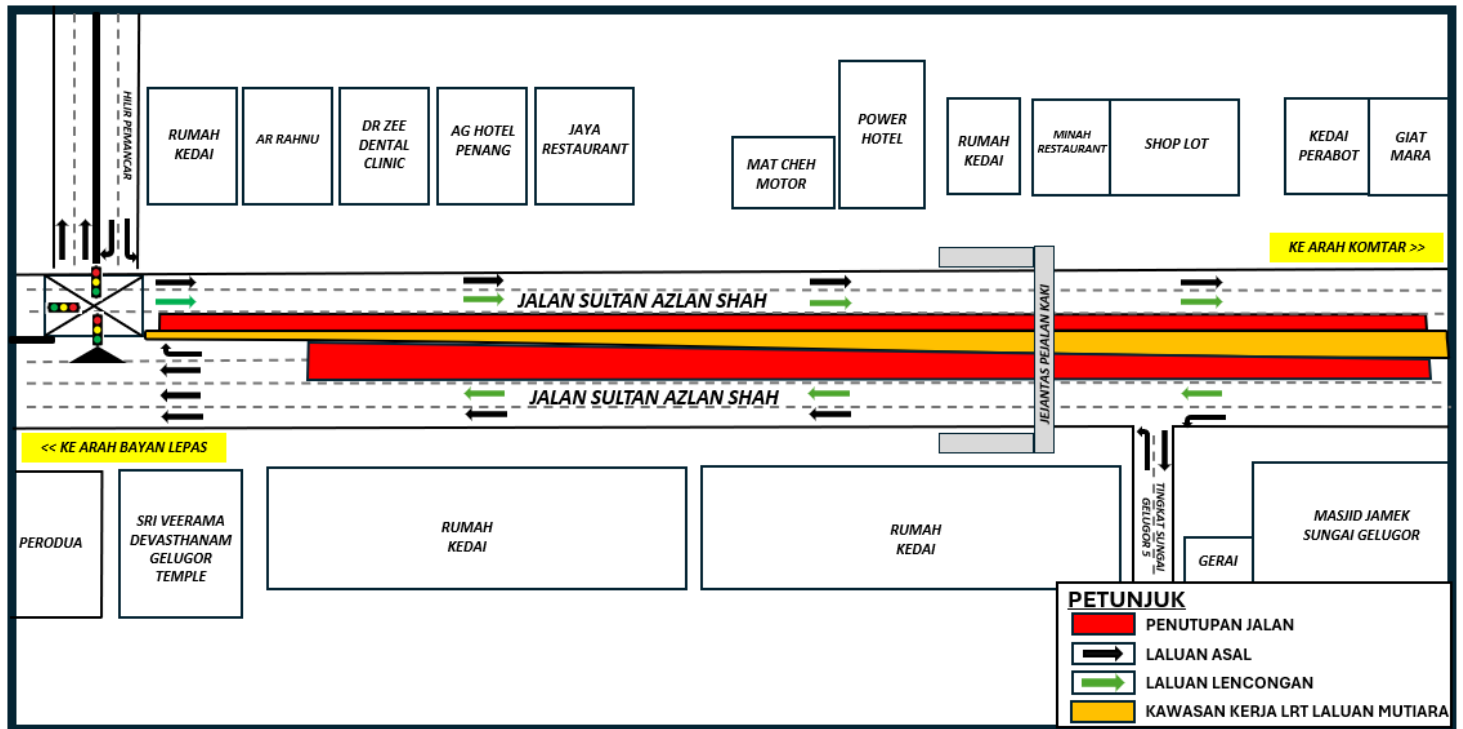
Penutupan ini akan melibatkan laluan laju di kedua-dua arah di antara di antara Masjid Jamek Sungai Gelugor dan Kuil Sri Veerama Devasthanam. Walau bagaimanapun, dua lorong di kedua-dua arah akan sentiasa dibuka sepanjang tempoh penutupan ini (seperti yang ditunjukkan di dalam peta).

Penutupan ini diperlukan bagi memberi laluan kepada kerja-kerja awalan bagi Projek Rapid Transit Aliran Ringan (LRT) Pulau Pinang: Laluan Mutiara - Pakej CMC1, yang melibatkan kerja-kerja pemindahan utiliti, cerucuk, pembinaan tiang struktur serta kerja-kerja lain yang berkaitan.

Pengguna jalan raya dinasihatkan untuk berhati-hati ketika melalui kawasan ini. Papan tanda, kon-kon trafik dan pengawal bendera akan ditempatkan di lokasi berkenaan untuk membantu melancarkan kawalan trafik dan keselamatan pengguna kenderaan di laluan tersebut.

Reason	UTILITY RELOCATION, BORED PILING, STRUCTURAL PIER CONSTRUCTION AND RELATED WORKS FOR THE PENANG LRT PROJECT

Please be informed that a long-term partial lane closure along Jalan Sultan Azlan Shah (both directions) will be implemented 24 hours daily from 1 August 2026 to 1 August 2029, over a period of 1096 days.

The traffic management plan is as follows:

This closure will involve the fast lanes in both directions between Masjid Jamek Sungai Gelugor and Sri Veerama Devasthanam Temple. However, the two lanes in each direction will remain open throughout the closure period (please refer to the attached map).

The closure is necessary to facilitate preliminary works for the Penang Light Rail Transit (LRT) Project: Mutiara Line – Package CMC1, including utility relocation, bored piling, structural pier construction and other related works.

Motorists are advised to follow directional signage. During the closure period, the PML Project Emergency Response Team will be onsite to assist with traffic management. Safety barriers, traffic cones and flagmen will also be deployed to ensure the safety of all road users. For further information, please refer to the map below.
