Tujuan	KERJA-KERJA PERPARITAN DAN PELEBARAN JALAN.

Untuk makluman, penutupan separa laluan secara berkala jangka panjang di Kampung Relau dan Jalan Tun Dr. Awang akan dilaksanakan dari 1 Ogos 2026 hingga 15 Oktober 2026. Tempoh penutupan adalah di antara jam 8:00 pagi hingga 4:00 petang, selama 75 hari.

Pelan pengurusan trafik adalah seperti berikut:

Penutupan ini akan melibatkan:

- 1. Lorong paling kiri di hadapan Penang International Commercial City (PICC), menghala ke Bayan Lepas;**
- 2. Lorong paling kiri di hadapan Stesen Minyak Petron Bukit Jambul, menghala ke KOMTAR;**
- 3. Lorong paling kiri bermula susur masuk dari Jalan Sultan Azlan Shah ke Jalan Kampung Relau hingga ke susur keluar ke Jalan Tun Dr. Awang, di antara Stesen Minyak Shell dan i-Avenue; dan**
- 4. Lorong paling kiri bermula susur masuk kiri dari Jalan Tun Dr. Awang ke Jalan Kampung Relau hingga ke SMK Sungai Nibong, menghala ke KOMTAR.**

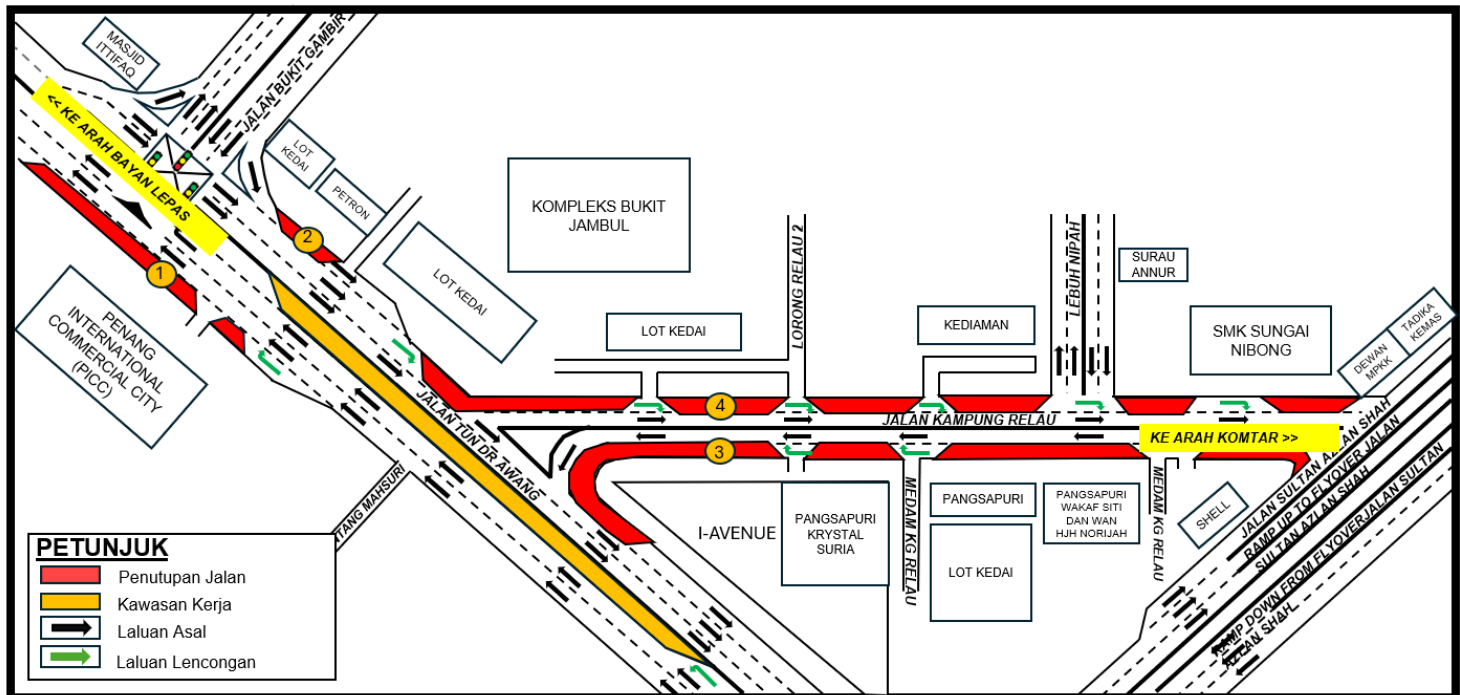
Walau bagaimanapun, lorong lain akan kekal dibuka untuk laluan trafik (Sila rujuk peta yang dilampirkan).

Penutupan ini diperlukan bagi memberi laluan kepada kerja-kerja awalan bagi Projek Rapid Transit Aliran Ringan (LRT) Pulau Pinang: Laluan Mutiara - Pakej CMC1 yang melibatkan kerja-kerja perparitan dan pelebaran jalan.

Pengguna jalan raya dinasihatkan untuk berhati-hati ketika melalui kawasan ini. Papan tanda, kon-kon trafik dan pengawal bendera akan ditempatkan di lokasi berkenaan untuk membantu melancarkan kawalan trafik dan keselamatan pengguna kenderaan di laluan tersebut.

Reason	DRAINAGE AND ROAD WIDENING WORKS.

Please be informed that a long-term intermittent partial lane closure along Jalan Kampung Relau and Jalan Tun Dr. Awang will be implemented from 1 August 2026 to 15 October 2026. The closure will be implemented from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, over a period of 75 days.

The traffic management plan is as follows:

The closures will involve:

- 1. The leftmost lane in front of Penang International Commercial City (PICC), towards Bayan Lepas;**
- 2. The leftmost lane in front of the Petron Bukit Jambul Petrol Station, towards KOMTAR;**
- 3. The leftmost lane from the entry slip road from Jalan Sultan Azlan Shah to Jalan Kampung Relau, up to the exit slip road to Jalan Tun Dr. Awang, between the Shell Petrol Station and i-Avenue; and**
- 4. The leftmost lane from the entry slip road from Jalan Tun Dr. Awang to Jalan Kampung Relau, up to SMK Sungai Nibong, towards KOMTAR.**

However, the other lanes will remain open to traffic, (as shown in the attached map).

This closure is necessary to facilitate preliminary works for the Penang Light Rail Transit (LRT) Project: Mutiara Line – CMC1 Package, which includes drainage and road widening works.

Motorists are advised to follow directional signage. During the closure period, the PML Project Emergency Response Team will be onsite to assist with traffic management. Safety barriers, traffic cones and flagmen will also be deployed to ensure the safety of all road users. For further information, please refer to the map below.
