PENUTUPAN LALUAN SEPARA BERKALA PANJANG DI JALAN SULTAN AZLAN SHAH

Tujuan	MENGENAL PASTI DAN PENGALIHAN UTILITI

Untuk makluman, penutupan separa laluan secara berkala jangka panjang waktu malam di Jalan Sultan Azlan Shah akan dilaksanakan bermula 1 September 2026 hingga 6 Oktober 2026. Tempoh masa penutupan adalah di antara jam 10:00 malam hingga 5:00 pagi, selama 35 hari. Pelan pengurusan trafik adalah seperti berikut:

Penutupan ini akan melibatkan:

- 1. Laluan paling kiri di antara persimpangan lampu isyarat Kompleks Sunny Point dan Padang Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM), menghala ke Komtar; dan**
- 2. Laluan paling kiri di antara Kem Tentera Batu Uban dan Persimpangan lampu isyarat Kompleks Sunny Point, menghala ke Bayan Lepas.**

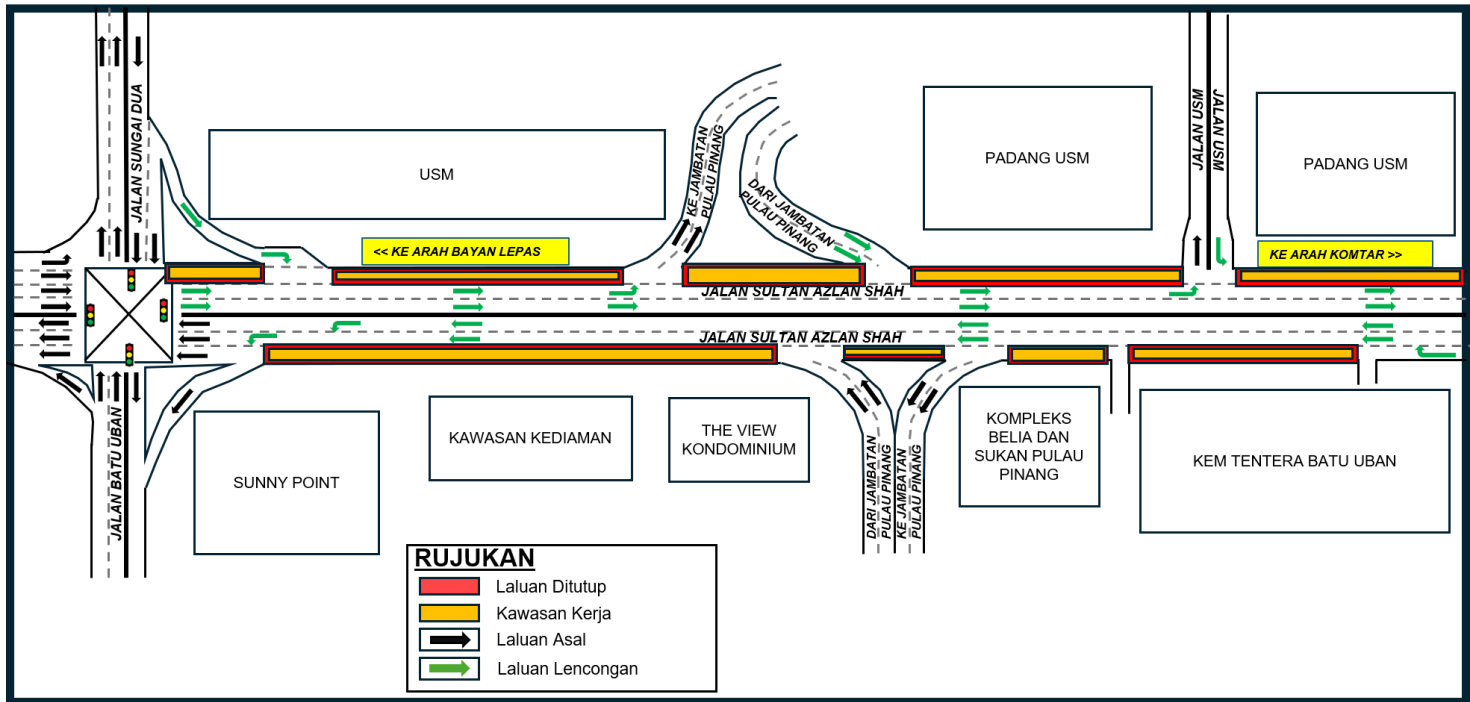
Walau bagaimanapun, lorong lain akan sentiasa dibuka untuk laluan trafik (seperti yang ditunjukkan di dalam peta yang dilampirkan).

Penutupan ini diperlukan bagi memberi laluan kepada kerja-kerja awalan bagi Projek Rapid Transit Aliran Ringan (LRT) Pulau Pinang: Laluan Mutiara - Pakej CMC1 yang melibatkan kerja-kerja pengalihan utiliti.

Pengguna jalan raya dinasihatkan untuk berhati-hati ketika melalui kawasan ini. Papan tanda, kon-kon trafik dan pengawal bendera akan ditempatkan di lokasi berkenaan untuk membantu melancarkan kawalan trafik dan keselamatan pengguna kenderaan di laluan tersebut.

LONG-TERM PERIODIC PARTIAL ROAD CLOSURE ALONG JALAN SULTAN AZLAN SHAH

Date	01 September 2026 - 06 October 2026
Time	10.00 pm – 5.00 am
Duration	35 days
Reason	IDENTIFY AND RELOCATION UTILITIES

Please be informed a long-term intermittent partial night lane closures along Jalan Sultan Azlan Shah will be implemented from 1 September 2026 to 6 October 2026. The closure will be implemented from 10:00 AM to 5:00 AM, over a period of 35 days. The traffic management plan is as follows:

The implementation of the closures will involve:

- 1. Leftmost lane between the Sunny Point Complex traffic light junction and the field of University of Science Malaysia (USM), towards Komtar; and**
- 2. Leftmost lane between the Batu Uban Army Camp and the Sunny Point Complex traffic light junction, towards Bayan Lepas.**

However, the other lanes will remain open to traffic (as shown in the attached map).

These closures are necessary to facilitate preliminary works for the Penang Light Rail Transit (LRT) Project: Mutiara Line – CMC1 Package, which includes utility relocation works.

Road users are advised to follow directional signage. During the closure period, the PML Project Emergency Response Team will be onsite to assist with traffic management. Safety barriers, traffic cones and flagmen will also be deployed to ensure the safety of all road users. For further information, please refer to the map below.
